Books to be kept at HOME (to be brought only when required)	Books to be kept at SCHOOL (in classroom cupboards)
Textbooks of Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, EVS, Computer Science for all classes to be brought to class as per the instructions by the respective subject teachers.	All Workbooks
Class 1 & II - Maths Sem B, - English Term 2 & 3	- Test Paper Books - Art / Craft / Drawing Books
Class III, IV , V- Maths Sem B	- Notebooks after correction (sent home only on weekends) - Any other subject-specific activity books not required for home study
Class VII & VIII - Maths Part II, - SST Part II	KG I,II, III - World of Colours - Colour Carnival (Art& Craft), - World of Letters English Activity Book - World of Numbers Maths Activity Book

- **Books as per Timetable:** Students must bring books strictly according to the class timetable.
- **Regular Monitoring:** Teachers will periodically check school bags to ensure that students are not carrying extra books/ unnecessary items.

We seek your cooperation in ensuring that your child packs the school bag strictly according to the daily timetable and avoids carrying extra books or materials. Kindly guide and monitor your ward regularly to support this initiative.
